

Key Instant Recall Facts Year 5 – Autumn 2

I know the multiplication and division facts for all the times tables up to 12×12 .

By the end of this half term, children should know the following facts. The aim is for them to recall these facts instantly.

Search 'multiplication square' online to see all times tables, or request a multiplication square from your child's teacher.



Vocabulary

What is 8 multiplied by 6?

What is 7 times 4?

What is 81 divided by 9?

What is the product of 5 and 7?

Children should be able to answer these questions in any order, including missing number questions. e.g. $6 \times \underline{\quad} = 72$ or $\underline{\quad} \div 7 = 4$

Top tips

The secret to success is practising little and often. Use time wisely. Can you practise these KIRFs while walking to school or during a car journey? You do not need to practise them all at once; perhaps you could have a fact of the day. If you would like more ideas, please speak to your child's teacher.

Practical resources

Use a multiplication square to practise multiplication facts together. Can you child tell you the linked division fact, and three facts linked to the multiplication fact to create the fact family?
