

# Key Instant Recall Facts Year 1 – Spring 1

I know doubles and halves of numbers to 10.

*By the end of this half term, children should know the following facts. The aim is for them to recall these facts instantly.*

$0 + 0 = 0$

$\text{half of } 0 = 0$

$1 + 1 = 2$

$\text{half of } 2 = 1$

$2 + 2 = 4$

$\text{half of } 4 = 2$

$3 + 3 = 6$

$\text{half of } 6 = 3$

$4 + 4 = 8$

$\text{half of } 8 = 4$

$5 + 5 = 10$

$\text{half of } 10 = 5$

$6 + 6 = 12$

$7 + 7 = 14$

$8 + 8 = 16$

$9 + 9 = 18$

$10 + 10 = 20$

The secret to success is practising little and often. Use time wisely. Can you practise these KIRFs while walking to school or during a car journey? Ping Pong – In this game, the parent says 'Ping' and the child replies 'Pong'. Then the parent says a number and the child doubles it. For the harder version, the adult can say 'Pong' and the child replies 'Ping' then halves the number.
