## **Sheffield Attendance - Changes to Penalty Notice Fines**

Dear Families,

You may have already heard that a new National Framework for Penalty Notices is being introduced in August 2024. Sheffield City Council will be following the framework and so fines for term time leave will be changing. Fines are increasing quite significantly so you will be charged a lot more if your child takes more than 5 consecutive days leave. Each parent will be charged for each child and the fine is increasing to £160 per parent, per child. Fines will also be considered if a child has 10 unauthorised sessions of absence in a 10-week period. The poster attached with this newsletter sets out the changes in more detail. Here at Pye Bank, whilst we understand that many families do take term time leave to visit family or for cheaper holidays, we will be applying these changes in line with the Local Authority and charging the new rates. Please do consider this before booking a holiday. We will be holding a coffee morning next half term where we will be discussing the changes and giving parents the chance to ask questions.
