

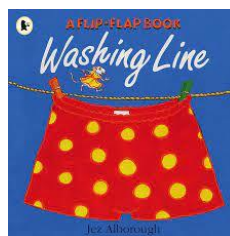

### KEY VOCABULARY



Our story this half term is 'The Washing Line' by Jez Alborough.

### MATHS

Children will be –  
 Finding out about number 5 and what different ways we can see and make 5.  
 Matching amounts to numbers from 1 to 5.  
 Comparing groups of objects to say when they have more or less.  
 Exploring different weights and using the language heavy and light.

### COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE

The children will be –  
 Listening out for all the sounds in words and blending them together to make words. They will be talking like a robot to segment and say the sounds in words.  
 This helps the children as they begin early reading and writing.

### LITERACY

Children will be –  
 Joining in with repeated phrases of our story and making guesses to who they think the clothes belong to and why?  
 They will be building and saying simple sentences linked to our story.  
 They will be acting out the story and dressing different animals and dolls.  
 The children will retell the story using simple props.  
 The children will be continuing to practise their names every day and look out for the letters of their name in and around the classroom.

### CREATIVE DEVELOPMENT

Children will be –  
 Following patterns and creating their own pattern designs for clothes, for example, stripey or spotty then some repetitive patterns.

### PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

The children will be –  
 Having some taster PE sessions in the hall to get them ready for starting F2 and to practise sports day games and races.  
 Following patterns with different types of mark making equipment to support their pencil grip.

### UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD

Children will be –  
 Exploring different materials and how they change when they get wet.  
 Talking about what they can feel and what they can see.  
 Thinking about what they want to be when they grow up and looking at different jobs and how these people help us.

### PSHE

Children will be –  
 Joining in with circle time games building up their turn taking skills.  
 Thinking about next year and what they are excited about doing as they move to F2 or stay in Nursery.  
 Thinking about what we have achieved this year and what we are proud of.
