Physical feature: things that are naturally there. They include hills and mountains.



Local: If something is local, it is near to where you live.



Community: A community is a group of people who live in the same place.



Aerial view: This is the type of view that a map gives us. It is taken from an aircraft looking down on the location.

Flower


