United Kingdom - The UK is a nation that is made up of the countries England, Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland.



Country - An area of land with boundaries which fits within a continent. A country has its own government.



Capital City - The city that is the main centre of business and government within a country.



Season - A season is each part of the year that is noticeable by different weather conditions.



Climate - The climate of a place is the general weather conditions it usually displays. Eg. A cold climate.



Weather - The state of the atmosphere at a particular place and time including hear, clouds, sunshine, wind and rain.



Atlas - A book of maps.



Globe - A ball-shaped object with a map of the world on it.

The UK is in Europe and it is made up of 4 countries -England, Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland.

It is surrounded by 4 main seas - the Atlantic Ocean, the North Sea, the Irish Sea and the **Enalish Channel.**




- 1. The United Kingdom (UK) is made up of 4 countries - England, Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland.
