


### KEY VOCABULARY



**Dark:** a lack of light in a place.



**Light:** energy that comes from the sun that lets you see things.




**Sight:** the ability to/being able to see.



**Light Source:** the place where light comes from.



**Shadow:** an area of darkness that results when light is blocked.




**Sun:** the ball of fire in the sky that gives us heat and light.

### KEY CONCEPT

#### How do we see?

We can see objects because light rays bounce off them and into our eyes. This is known as reflection.



Some objects block the light rays and shadows are created.




1. Light is a form of energy.
